Brief Life History of Alonzo F

When Alonzo F Anderson was born in November 1856. in Harford, Maryland, United States, his father, George Anderson, was 29 and his mother, Mary Elizabeth Keen, was 28. He married Catherine C Abels on 22 April 1879, in Camden, Gloucester, New Jersey, United States. They were the parents of at least 1 daughter. He lived in Aberdeen, Harford, Maryland, United States in 1920 and District 2, Harford, Maryland, United States in 1930. He died on 8 December 1937, in Harford, Maryland, United States, at the age of 81, and was buried in Weslevan Chapel Cemetery, Aberdeen, Harford, Maryland, United States.
